## THE PLATES

This volume contains images of monuments from Sections A and B only. Many of the stones in these two sections are no longer readable and others are deteriorating rapidly, the worst affected are those lying flat and face up and mainly from the 17<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup> century. Some much later stones have also succumbed to the elements as shown in the plate for Section B, Plot B6. Below I have given the inscriptions for each of the monuments illustrated, with the plate numbers given in bracket at the end of the monument type. The plate numbers are located on the back of each page. Each image is numbered with the section and plot number in the order of the inscriptions given below with a few exceptions, as some plates contain images of two monuments.

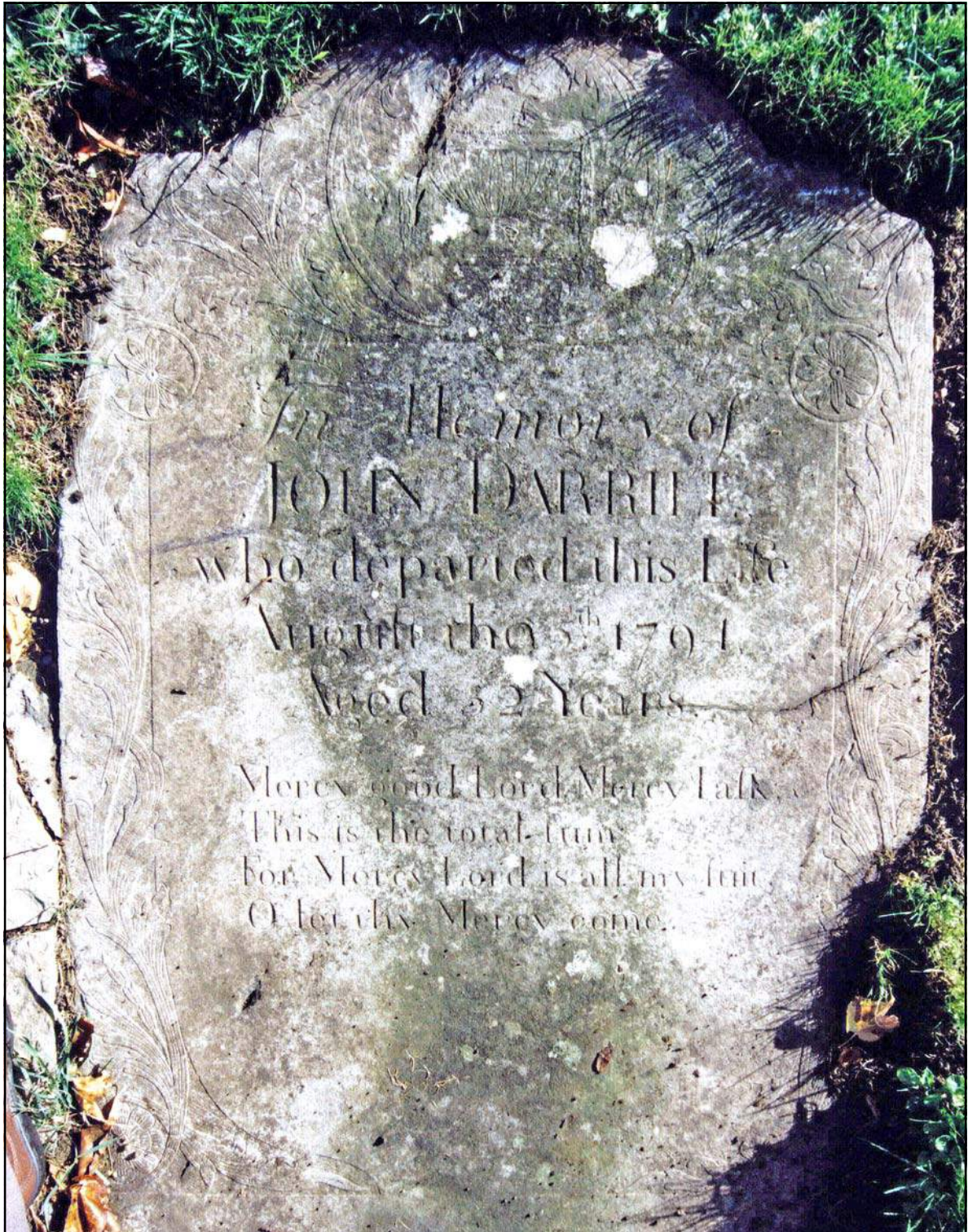
