## NOTES AND NEWS.

The Vicar and Churchwardens of Badsey wish to thank all who kindly assisted in spring-cleaning the church and tidying the churchyard.

Under command of Capt. Harry and Lieut. Burlingham, over a hundred non-commissioned officers and men of the local company of Territorials attended the Church Parade at Badsey on Low Sunday. The Vicar officiated, and preached from Ex. xv. 3: "The Lord is a man of war." Mr. C. E. Sladden read the lessons.

The Children's Lenten Savings at Badsey (inclusive of a small sum collected last year) amounted to 12s. 2½d., and those of the Wickhamford children to 1s. 6½d. The money has been forwarded to the Church of England Waifs and Strays Society.

Sunday, May 8th, will be the 25th anniversary of the laying of the foundation-stone of the new aisle of Badsey Church. The event will be commemorated by the singing of the hymns and anthem used at the ceremony, the anthem ("O Lord, my God") being Malan's beautiful setting of words taken from Solomon's prayer at the dedication of the Temple.

The services on Whit-Sunday will be the same as those on Easter Day, a list of which will be found in the March number of the *Magazine*.

The members of the Vicarage Sewing Class will hold their annual Sale of Work on Tuesday, May 24th, from 2.30 to 6.30. The sale will take place, if fine, on the Vicarage Lawn; if wet, in the Parish Room.
