THE CHURCH IN WALES.

At a Conference of the Evesham Deanery on March 18th it was resolved. "That this Conference is resolutely opposed to the disestablishment and disendowment of the Church in Wales as being unjust and dishonourable to the nation, hostile to the cause of true religion, and a serious hindrance to the work of Christian people in Wales."

There was considerable difference of opinion as to the advisability of including any reference to disestablishment in the resolution, but the Conference was almost unanimous in condemning disendowment.
