

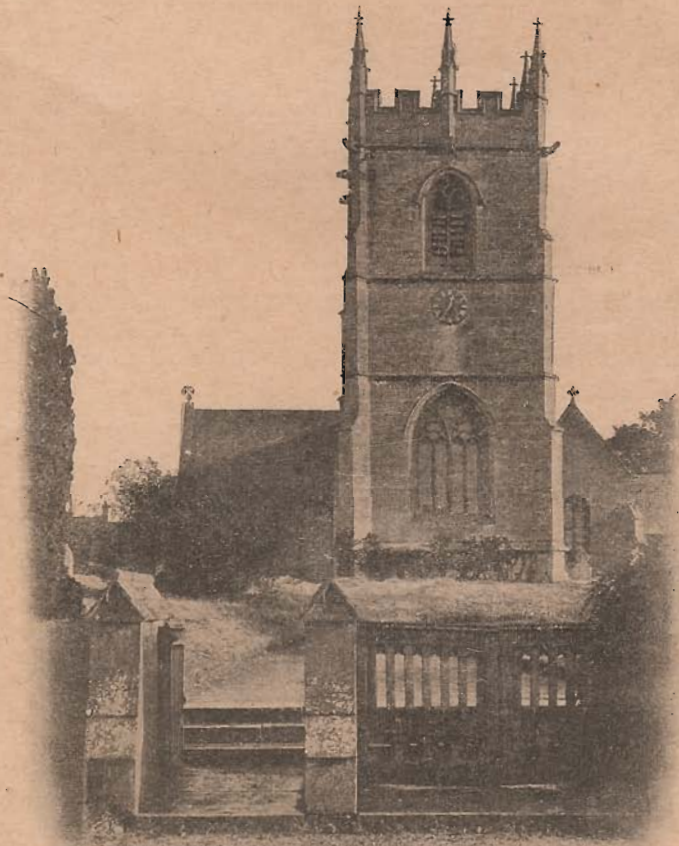

## CHOIR FESTIVAL.

The success attending the Festival of Parish Choirs held in All Saints' Church, Evesham, on Wednesday, June 26th, was very gratifying and encouraging to all concerned. Although the music was in a way simple there was enough in it to tax the skill of the average village choir, but patient and painstaking practice had its reward in a really inspiring service. It is a pity the congregation was not larger, but even in this respect the Festival showed an improvement on those of recent years. The Bishop of Worcester preached an excellent sermon to the assembled choirs, taking as his text Psalm CIII., v. 2.
