

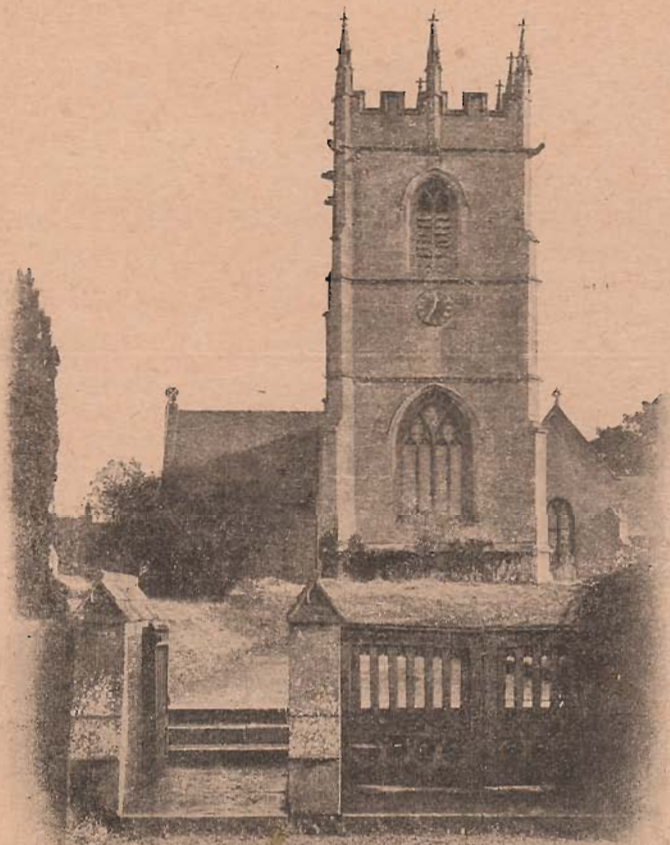

## HARVEST FESTIVAL.

Sunday, October 5th, was observed as the Harvest Festival at Wickhamford. Owing, no doubt, mainly to the inclemency of the weather the evening congregation was one of the smallest on record. The collections, however, which were for the Evesham Cottage Hospital, were well up to the average and amounted, with the contributions of those who were absent, to the satisfactory sum of £4 5s.

The interior of church was tastefully decorated by Mrs. Taylor, Mrs. G. Agg, Mrs. Hartwell, Miss Pethard, Miss M. G. Pethard, Miss P. M. Pethard. Offerings of flowers, fruit and vegetables were received from Mr. Moss-Milne, Mrs. Walters, Mrs. J. Colley, Mr. J. W. Mason, Mrs. Pethard, Miss Pethard, Mr. Swift, Mr. Taylor, Mr. G. Agg, Mr. W. Smith, Mrs. Hartwell, Mrs. Sands, and Mrs. Griffin.

The fruit and vegetables (with the exception of the grapes which were divided among sick and infirm parishioners) were sent to the Christ Church Mission, Poplar. Hamper of fruit and vegetables ready packed for the Mission were received from Mr. Mason, Mr. W. Smith, Mr. Richards, Mr. G. Agg, Messrs. Thorne & Shindler, Mr. Cox, Mr. W. Jones, Mr. Brysdale, Mr. J. Smith, Mr. Carter and Mr. Swift. The carriage to London was defrayed by Mr. Cressy, Mr. Swift, Mr. Moss-Blundell and the Vicar.

## NOTES AND NEWS.
