IN MEMORIAM.

Universal sympathy is felt for Mrs. C. H. Crane who, after hoping against hope for six months, has at last been informed by the War Office that her husband, Private C. H. Crane, of the 4th Worcesters, must be regarded as having been killed in action on or about August 6. A full congregation assembled for the memorial service held on March 7th. The service was choral and the rendering of the music was a credit to both choir and organist. In the prayer for the departed, which was taken from the Worcester Dio cesan Monthly Intercession Paper, mention was also made of Lionel R. Holmes, brother of Mrs. Thelwall, late of Badsey, and Harold Gaskin, formerly of Badsey, both of whom have lost their lives since the last service of the kind was held, the former being killed in the first landing at Gallipoli and the latter dying in Hospital at Alexandria.—R.I.P.
