WELCOME TO THE REV. PETER MITCHELL & TO MRS. MITCHELL

The arrival of a new Vicar is an important and exciting moment in the life of a Parish Church and the Community which it serves. On Tuesday, 16th September, at 7.30 pm the Lord Bishop of Worcester will "institute" the Rev.Peter Mitchell as Vicar of Badsey with Aldington and Vicar of Wickhamford, and the Archdeacon of Worcester, the Venerable J.C. Williams, will "induct" him with the full legal authority for the two Parish Churches. Archdeacon Williams is retiring from his high office at the end of September and the day is thus made more memorable by the fact that it is the Archdeacon's last Induction, performed at Badsey in the middle of the celebrations of the Diocese's 13th Centenary.

We extend to the Rev. Peter Mitchell and to his Wife and Daughter the very warmest of welcomes, and we hope that their stay among us will be long and happy. We look forward to Mr. Mitchell's Ministry with lively anticipation. He comes at a time of challenge and will doubtless soon discover plenty of problems to be resolved. He will need our prayers continually and a congregation fully committed to support his leadership. He will conduct a celebration of the Eucharist at Badsey at 10.00 a.m. the morning after his Induction; four days later comes the Badsey Church Fete and twelve days after that the Badsey Harvest Supper. These events will give us early opportunities to meet our new Vicar and to demonstrate to him in practical fashion our united determination to respond to the Church's needs.

The Service of Institution is due to start at 7.30 p.m. and we hope that you will be in your seats in Badsey Church by 7.15 p.m. We shall be welcoming a coach load of visitors from Lund, a warm Lancashire tribute to the affection that Mr. Mitchell has built up in his last Parish. Other visitors will include the clergy and their wives from the Evesham Deanery, and Don Hartwell and Ralph Taylor, the Sidesmen for the occasion, will do their best to squeeze the congregations of our two Parishes into Badsey Church. After the Service there will be refreshments in the hall of Badsey Village Primary School, the catering being in the hands of Mrs. Leigh of School Lane, assisted by a Committee of Badsey and Wickhamford Ladies; all are welcome.

MAINTENANCE of the Church, Churchyard and Vicarage

It has come to our knowledge that parishioners cannot understand why we appealed for voluntary help to decorate the interior of the Vicarage. The reason is that we, the members of the churches in Badsey, Aldington and Wickhamford, are responsible for the maintenance of all the items headed above, but only the interior of the Vicarage. The Worcester Diocesan Parsonages Board inspected the Vicarage in March and instructed on the work necessary. This inspection is normally carried out on a quinquennial basis, which would have been due next year, but as a result of the present comprehensive effort no more work should be necessary for six years at least.

Having explained the situation, may we say "thank you" to those who have helped in the work, and if you so wish we would be happy to accept a donation towards the balance of the cost which exceeds the grant given by the Parsonages Board.
