# St James, Badsey with Aldington Parish Newsletter January 2004

By now, many of you will know that we will be leaving these parishes in the second half of March. The announcement was made on 30th November at The Christingle service in each parish. By the time we depart, I will have been Vicar here for over seven years.

Kathryn will be working at the Medical Centre at Lerwick in the Shetland Islands for twelve months before returning to her business in Evesham. I will be working part-time for The Rector of Lerwick and Burra Voe whilst also spending a part of my time engaged in research and writing. At the end of the twelve months I shall be seeking a new appointment in the area of South Worcestershire.

The actual leaving date and the precise arrangements have not yet been fixed - indeed, had I been moving to another Church appointment on the same time scale then no-one (including myself) would have known about the move until early in January.

The arrangements for the appointment of a new Incumbent are complex, lengthy and imposed by an Act of Parliament over which the Diocese of Worcester has no control. Nevertheless, I will be giving advice to The Churchwardens and Church Councils as to the best way to keep the process as short as possible.

Leaving anywhere produces very mixed feelings and when we first began thinking through the possibility of this move my feelings about the whole venture were quote negative. However, a visit to The Shetland Islands last April changed my mind completely. The process since then has been delayed several times and at one stage it all looked as though it would never happen. Kathryn has been very careful about finding the right person to do her job whilst she is away. Now, everything appears to be in place.

Eisewhere in the Newsletter you will find cletails about Weddings and Baptisms after I have departed. In the February edition you will hopefully find the full details of our departure as well as a brief guide to the geography of The Shetlands. The one thing of which we can be certain is that life there will be very different to life in The Vale of Evesham.


