- (c) PURCHASE OF ALCOHOL FOR PERSONS UNDER 18
- (d) DRUNK AND DISORDERLY
- (e) DEPOSITING AND LEAVING LITTER

Depending on the offence the fine can be either £50 or £80. The fine for drinking offences can be given the next day if need be.
