Dear All,

By the time you read this we will probably have just celebrated Harvest Festival; leading up to this, a couple of weeks ago there was a reading in church which told of someone who owned a vineyard. It was the time of harvest and he hired people to gather the grapes. He did this several times during the day; some worked all day, some half a day and others only an hour. At the end of the day, when the time came to pay them they were each paid the same. As you can imagine some were delighted while the others were outraged.

If we see the landowner in the parable or story as representing God and that we are the workers in the field, it tells us something about Him. It certainly does not make financial sense, but it does demonstrate God's generosity in all that he gives us, and our Harvest Festival is one occasion to give thanks for the abundance of the crops we gather.

The world produces enough food for everyone, unfortunately it is not evenly distributed; we in the west have stockpiles, while others are starving. I know that it is easy to say and very difficult, if not impossible in practical terms, but if only we could be more like the landowner in the parable when it comes to the world's harvest

Let us thank God that he is generous to us, and let us all try to be generous to one another, and let us also remember that nothing is impossible with the help of God.
