# **Thought For The Month From**



What is Pilgrim? Pilgrim is a major new teaching and discipleship resource from the Church of England. It aims to help every local church create a place where people can explore the Christian faith

together and see how it can be lived out each day. Pilgrim takes a different approach to other Christian programmes. It approaches the great issues of faith not through persuasion, but participation in a pattern of contemplation and discussion with a group of fellow travellers.

Pilgrim is comprised of two stages: the Follow stage for those very new to faith, and the Grow stage for those who want to go further. Each stage contains four short six-session courses which focus on a major theme of Christian Pilgrim's approach

It starts at the very beginning: Pilgrim assumes very little understanding or knowledge of the Christian faith.

It focuses on Jesus Christ: Pilgrim aims to equip people to follow Jesus Christ as disciples in the whole of their lives.

It flows from the Scriptures: The primary focus of each session is a group of people engaging with the Bible together.



REGULARS, VOLUNTEERS AND CONSCRIPTS:
THE WORCESTERSHIRE REGIMENT IN THE FIRST WORLD WAR

by Professor Stephen Badsey of The University of Wolverhampton

Stephen Badsey, Professor of Conflict Studies in the Department of History, Politics and War Studies, and Co-Director of the First World War Research Group, is an internationally recognised specialist on the history and present practice of wartime propaganda and military-media relationships. He has held research positions at the Imperial War Museum and for the BBC, and for several years he was a member of the academic staff at the Royal Military Academy Sandhurst. He has written more than 100 books and articles. He appears and advises frequently for television and other media, and advises for academic, defence and governmental organisations. In the last five years he has been invited to address audiences in Denmark, Germany, Japan, South Africa, Estonia and the United States – and now he is coming to Badsey.

It is with great sadness that we have to announce the untimely death on 3<sup>rd</sup> October of Richard Phillips at the age of 67, who has died of a heart attack. Our heartfelt condolences go to Lizzie and to his son, Will. It is not an overstatement to say that, had it not been for Richard, The Badsey Society may never have been born. It was Richard who set up the Badsey website, www.badsey.net, and it was Richard who suggested a second edition of A Brief History of Badsey and Aldington. It was these two things which led directly to the founding of The Badsey Society in February 2002. Three further books followed, and DVDs. Our village is a richer place because of Richard's endeavours; we will miss him greatly.




Last Months Answer:


