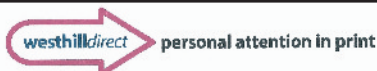

Now that Lent has finally come to an end and Easter is here, the church starts to think about new beginnings and new life. In this part of the world this process is made all the easier as the Easter season coincides with the beginnings of Spring. It is a time of great activity, and hopefully of

fruitful results to come.

This is all particularly resonant with me at the moment as I begin my new ministry here in the Benefice. There is plenty for me to be getting on with, with lots of places to visit and new people to meet. But while all this is very exciting, there is such a thing as too much activity. Just before I moved here, a wise friend of mine reminded me that a good gardener doesn't start digging up a new garden in the first year. How can they know what wonderful flowers still waiting to bloom they might inadvertently destroy? Better to wait and see what treasures lie still beneath the surface.

So while there is much for me to do and learn, there is also a lot of waiting and seeing to be done. I have no

doubt that there are many treasures lying beneath the surface in our churches, many wonderful things being done day in and day out that are perhaps not always immediately visible. I always look for what I call the 'quiet ministries', those people who quietly get on with Christian witness in their care for others; perhaps looking after an elderly relative or neighbour, or those who befriend the lonely, or those who work for the good of the natural world. These quiet ministries can take any one of a thousand different forms and are no less important than the ministries we see in services every week.

It is these quiet ministries that I especially want to see grow and flourish, but it takes time and patience. Like a good gardener, better to see what is already here than make changes immediately. This is something I am particularly looking forward to.

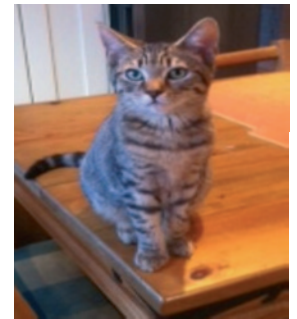
