### **Harvest Festival 2016**

#### **Badsey Church**

### 2nd October - Starting at 11am

The tradition of celebrating Harvest Festival in churches began in 1843, when the Reverend Robert Hawker invited parishioners to a special thanksgiving service at his church at Morwenstow in Cornwall. This led to the custom of decorating churches with home-grown produce for the Harvest Festival service.

The traditional ways of celebrating the harvest still survive today in rural communities. Nowadays, we take gifts of fruit, vegetables, tins and packets to church and present them during the harvest service whilst the harvest hymn 'We plough the fields and scatter the good seed on the land, But it is fed and watered by God's almighty hand' is sung. After the service, these gifts are distributed to the elderly and needy of the community.

Badsey church sends their harvest gifts to Caring Hands in the Vale.

Caring Hands is an organisation within the Church that continually seeks to help relieve poverty and need in the Vale of Evesham. Those referred to Caring Hands receive food parcels, toiletry packs, bedding, clothing, sleeping bags and blankets free of charge depending on their circumstances. Those in need can also receive a free hot meal twice a week at the Caring Hands Diner.

Everyone is invited to join in the celebration and thanksgiving for harvest at Badsey Church.

After the service all gifts will go to Caring Hands in the Vale
