*Clerk, M. A.,* personally appearing before Us to be licensed to the  
*Perpetual Curacy or Vicarage of Badsey with Aldington* —

in the County of *Worcester* — within our Diocese and Jurisdiction did before  
his *license* — thereto in our presence make and subscribe the Declaration  
of Assent and the Declaration against Simony, and did also take the Oath of Allegiance  
now required by Law to be made subscribed and taken; and did also make Oath that he  
would pay true and Canonical obedience to Us and our Successors Bishops of Worcester  
in all lawful and honest commands,

Given under our hand and Seal the *eleventh* day of *July* —  
in the year of our Lord One thousand nine hundred and *three* — and in the  
*second* year of our Consecration.
