thereto in our presence make and subscribe the Declaration of Assent and the Declaration
against Simony as by Law required; and did take the Oath of Allegiance as by Law
required; and did also make Oath that he would pay true and Canonical obedience to us
and our Successors Bishops of *Worcester* in all lawful and honest
commands. And that he would faithfully observe the Statutes, Ordinances and laudable
customs of the said Cathedral Church so far as they concern him by reason of his obtaining
the said Honorary Canonry.
