AS acting Registrar of the Diocese of Worcester, and pursuant to the ~~Sixth Clause~~ of the late Act for the further support and maintenance of Stipendiary Curates, I herewith transmit to you a Copy of a Licence granted by the Lord Bishop of Worcester to the Reverend *Judith*

Quick to perform the Office of Stipendiary Curate in your Parish Church, to be by you deposited in the Parish Chest. And by the same Act it is provided, that, for such Copy, the Registrar shall be entitled to a Fee of *Ten Shillings*, to be allowed in the Account of the Churchwardens: and as the said Reverend *Judith Quick* has discharged such Fee upon the granting and Registering such Licence, you will be pleased to repay the same to him, and charge the same to the Parish, and you will oblige,

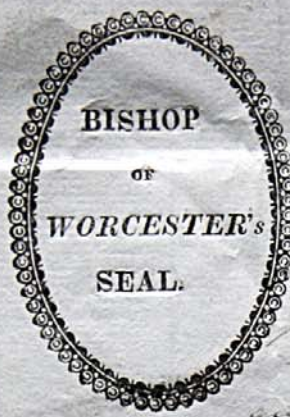

to continue only during pleasure to perform
the Office of Stipendiary Curate in the *parish*
and parish Church of Nadey with the
Chapel of Wickhamford in the County
of Worcester within our Diocese and
Province

in reading the Common Prayers, preaching and performing other
Ecclesiastical Duties belonging to the said Office, according to the
Form prescribed in the Book of Common Prayer, made and pub-
lished by authority of Parliament, and the Canons and Constituti-
ons in that behalf lawfully established and promulgated, and
not otherwise, or in any other Manner (You having first before
our Commission lawfully constituted

subscribed the Articles, taken the Oaths, and made and sub-
scribed the Declaration which in this Case are required by Law to
be subscribed, made and taken), And We do, by these presents,
assign unto you the yearly Stipend of *seventy five pounds*

for your maintenance in the said City
together with the use of the plate house for your
residence. the said stipend to be paid you by
the Rev. Charles Philpot perpetual Curate of

Nadey &c. In Testimony Whereof We have caused our Episcopal
Seal which We use in this Case, to be hereto affixed. Dated the
fourth day of *November* in the Year of our Lord
One Thousand Eight Hundred and *nineteen* and in the
twelfth Year of our *happiness*
