

Contract for Drainage of part of the Badsey Glebe Estate, for the Rev^d Charles Granville Gepp, Vicar by Messrs Webb & Nettle of Evesham, Drainage Engineers

The Rev^d C. G. Gepp hereby agrees with the said Messrs Webb & Nettle, that they shall execute the drainage works on about 48 acres of land upon the Badsey Glebe Estate upon the Specification following, for the sum of £5. 1. 2 per acre for the Drainage Works, and 5^s in addition per acre for haulage of pipes —

Specification.

Drains to be cut in every furrow 3 feet deep to be laid with 2 inch pipes into Main Drains sufficiently large to secure the efficient discharge of the drainage water.
