Motice is hereby given, that on the fourteenth day of October next, application will be made to His Majesty's Justices of the Peace, assembled at Quarter Sessions in and for the County of Worcester, for an Order for diverting and stopping up a certain footpath or Public Right of Way, in the Parish of Badsey, in the District of the Rural District of Evesham, in the County of Worcester, commencing at a point near a dwelling house in the occupation of Mr. George Brearley, on the Public Highway from Badsey to Willersey and traversing in a North Westerly direction a field known as "The Stockey" into the Village Street of Badsey aforesaid, near the Buildings in the occupation of Mr. Arthur Jones and others, such footpath or right of way being 467 feet in length and by substituting for and in lieu of the said Public Footpath or Right of Way, a Public Footpath commencing out of the said Public Highway from Badsey to Willersey, at a point about 40 feet North of the commencement of the existing Footpath and proceeding thence in a westerly direction for a distance of about 85 feet or thereabouts and then in a north westerly direction for a distance of 440 feet or thereabouts and then in a westerly direction for a distance of 33 feet or thereabouts and there uniting with the said Village Street of Badsey near the aforesaid Buildings, which said proposed new Footpath will be 458 feet in its total length.

End Motice is bereby further given that the Certificate of Two Justices having viewed the said Public Footpath or Right of Way so proposed to be diverted and stopped up and the line of the said Public Footpath proposed to be made as aforesaid and that such proposed new Footpath will be more commodious to the Public than the existing Public Footpath or Right of Way, together with the proof of the due publication of the several notices required by the Statutes and with the Plan of the Old and proposed New Footpath will be lodged with the Clerk of the Peace for the said County on or before the second day of September, 1912.
