To prune one Walnut	Consent is GRANTED to prune one Walnut subject to the following conditions:-

CONDITIONS

- i) that the work is carried out in a competent and safe manner
- ii) that the work is restricted to the removal of deadwood and selective thinning in order to improve the shape and make the tree safe.
- iii) that all debris is removed from site
- iv) that no fires are lit within 20 metres of the trees on site
- v) that the pruning work is carried out in the dormant season November - March
- vi) that the work is carried out to the complete satisfaction of the Local Planning Authority.
