25th day of March 1926. on a quarterly tenancy at the annual rent of 1/- to
be paid to the Vicar for the time being of the Parish of Wickhamford on

The tenancy hereby created is subject to the right of the Vicar for the time
being of Wickhamford and of all persons authorised by him to the exclusive use
