for placing a Memorial Tablet.



ERNEST, by Divine permission Bishop of Worcester,
to all whom it may concern and more especially
to the Parishioners and Inhabitants of the Parish
of Badsey in the County and our Diocese of
Worcester, G R E E T I N G :-

WHEREAS a Petition has been presented unto
our Vicar General in Spirituals and Principal
Official of our Consistorial and Episcopal Court of Worcester
by the Incumbent and Churchwardens of the Parish of Badsey afore-
said praying that a Licence or Faculty may be granted for the
purpose of placing on the South wall of the Transept in the
Parish Church of Badsey aforesaid a Tablet constructed of Brass,
in accordance with the design annexed to the said Petition, to
the memory of Arthur Herbert Savory, with the following inscrip-
tion thereon (which has been approved by us) :-

"In most loving memory of Arthur Herbert Savory, Resident
at Aldington Manor for 28 years. As Churchwarden he ***
greatly aided in the restoration of this Church in 1885 *
and was a constant worshipper near this spot. He died *
at Burley, Hampshire, 17th. July 1921, and was there laid
to rest".

AND WHEREAS our said Vicar General decreed that a Faculty be
issued as prayed AND WHEREAS a Notice or Citation was duly
served on Sunday the Twentyeighth day of May last, citing all
persons having or pretending to have any interest in the premises
to show cause why a Licence or Faculty should not issue for the
purpose aforesaid AND WHEREAS the said Citation has been
returned into the Registry of our said Consistorial Court and no
Appearance has been entered or cause shown against the grant of
the said Faculty Now WE the Bishop aforesaid proceeding by our

authority Ordinary and Episcopal and so far as by law we may or can ratify and confirm such decree of our said Vicar General and do hereby give and grant to the said Petitioners our Leave Licence and Faculty for the purpose aforesaid and for doing and performing all things necessary to be done in connection therewith PROVIDED ALWAYS that this Leave Licence or Faculty is only valid for one year from the date thereof so far as the doing and performing all things thereunder or in connection therewith.

GIVEN under the seal of our said Vicar General (which we use in this behalf) the Thirteenth day of June Anno Domini One thousand nine hundred and twentytwo and in the Fourth year of our Consecration.
