STEWARDING INFORMATION

Some of you have been stewarding for years and know exactly what to do, even so please check the list below and make sure you follow the procedure as it makes a huge difference to the smooth running of the Show. Please remember to collect and display the prize cards and to turn over the entry cards after the judging.

- 1 Check the position of the classes you are stewarding
- 2 Make sure that entry cards and exhibits do not have names showing
- 3 Introduce yourself to your judge and check that they have the judging information sheet. If not, collect one from Lizzie
- 4 Write down the judge's decision on the slip with the correct class number. You will be given these slips at the Show. Also check that the award is written on the green card
- 5 Please remind the judges that they do not have to award all the 1st 2nd and 3rd prizes if there are not enough entries, or the standard does not warrant them all. They should not have ties
- 6 Check that there is only one prize per entrant in each class
- 7 If there are no entries in a class write 'no entries' on the slip
- 8 Take the completed slips to the people writing out prize cards. If your judge has a number of classes to judge please take the slips in batches of about 5 to the writers. Do not leave all the slips until the judge has finished as this holds up proceedings
- 9 Collect the prize cards when they have been written out and make sure they are put on the correct entries
- 10 Turn over all entry cards so that the name shows
- 11 If you have any queries ask Lizzie
- 12 Return the card envelope to Lizzie when you have filled all the slips
- 13 Please help with writing out the prize cards.

This year we have tried to create a rota for help in the afternoon. A first draft is included. Please check if more help is needed with selling raffle tickets, gate, selling ice cream etc. This is always appreciated.

If you have any suggestions as to how things can be improved please write them below and return the sheet to Lizzie
