Planning Application 17/01687 - The Neuk, 3 Bretforton Road, Badsey, Evesham, WR11 7XG

We have been informed that this application for 60+ houses has been refused by Wychavon District Council. Documents can be seen by searching the above planning reference. There were over 80 comments made. The decision can be seen at http://docdro.id/7bWpiyJ.

However, we feel you should know that another identical application, 16/03030, was considered invalid by Wychavon. This application, which was **never** put out to public consultation, is now subject to an appeal. Comments on the refused 17/01687 will NOT be considered in this appeal, which is against another ruling. Wychavon tell us that they have forwarded comments **recently** received on 16/03030 to the Planning Inspectorate, but they advise that those wishing to comment do so directly to the Planning Inspectorate. If you wish to repeat your comment on 17/01687, go to https://acp.planninginspectorate.gov.uk/CaseSearch.aspx where you should enter the last 7 digits of the reference APP/H1840/W/17/3179185. The Local Planning Authority is Wychavon District Council and the LPA Reference 16/03030. A complete makeover...

The opening of Badsey Water Fountain took place on 22nd June 1912 and it has been a feature of Badsey since that date with very little work required. In the summer of 2017, to mark over 100 years of its being, Badsey Parish Council commissioned a local craftsman to restore the fountain to its original state with the exception of the ornate feature at the top. Chris Sherriff (pictured here with Badsey resident Keith Taylor) from Memory Lane Memorials, Pershore undertook the painstaking task of cleaning the fountain, adding drainage holes to the planters and re-constructing the top as well as adding a commemorative plaque. Work has now been completed. Keith Taylor and his wife Sheila, who have planted and maintained the planting for many years, keep the fountain well-stocked with seasonal colour.
