This Indenture made the third Day of April in the fourteenth year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord George
the third by the grace of God of Great Britain France and Ireland King Defender of the
Faith and so forth and in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and Sixty four Between William Collet of
Baddesey in the County of Worcester Yeoman of the one part and Richard Aldader of the same place Bladonite of the other
part witnesseth that for and in consideration of the sum of five shillings of lawful Money of Great Britain to the said said
William Collet in Hand at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents well and truly paid by the said Richard a
and Aldader the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said William Collet H^tis granted bargained and sold and by
these presents D^roth grant bargain and sell unto the said Richard Aldader his Executors Administrators and Assigns a
H^tis that steppage or Enclosure with the Stable Bladonites Shop Yard and Garden therunto belonging standing
and being in Baddesey aforesaid in the said County of Worcester formerly occupied by James Bird and afterwards by Henry
Bird his Son together with all and singular houses tenements Edifices Buildings Barns Stables Garths Outwards Courts
Yards Backyards Closes Woods Woods Woods & other Premises ffences Drays Waters Waterourses Commonage and so forth
Easements Paths Passages Privileges Profits Commodities Advantages Enclosures and hereditaments whatsoever to the said
steppage or Enclosure Stable Shop Yard and Garden belonging or in anywise pertaining or to or with the same or in
any part thereof now occupied or enjoyed or accepted reputed deemed taken or known as or for part part or member
thereof or belonging therunto and the diversion and diversion thereunder and remainder Rents Issues
and profits thereof **To have and to hold** the said steppage or Enclosure Stable Bladonites Shop Yard and
Garden and so forth and all and singular other the premises hereinbefore mentioned and intended to be so
hereby bargained and sold with their and every of their appurtenances unto the said Richard Aldader his executors
Administrators and Assigns from the Day next before the Day of the Date hereof for and during and unto
the full and true term of one whole Year from thence next ensuing and fully to be complete and ended a
yielding and paying therefore unto the said William Collet his heirs or assigns the Rent of one peper Com at
or upon the feast Day of Saint Michael the exchange next coming the Date hereof if the same shall be a
lawfully demandable **To the witnesseth** that by virtue hereof and by force of the Statute made for transforming leases into
Possession by the said Richard Aldader may be in the actual Possession of all and singular the said steppage
or Enclosure Stable Shop Yard Garden hereditaments and premises hereby bargained and sold or intended so
to be with their and every of their appurtenances and may be thereby enabled to accept and take a grant and
release of the freehold diversion and inheritance of the same premises to him the said Richard Aldader
his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Richard Aldader his heirs and assigns
for ever and to and for none other use intent or purpose whatsoever **In witness** whereof the parties first above
named to these present Indentures their hands and seals interchangingably have set the Day and Year first above
