Memorandum: Whereas we the undersigned  
Thomas Sharp of Bingham in the County of Worcester  
Esquire and Harriet Sharp the Wife of the said Thomas  
Sharp or one of us are or is seized of or otherwise  
will be entitled to Eight Cottages and Gardens situate at  
Bodney in the said County of Worcester, now or late in the  
Occupation of Charles Hartlett and others Subject to the  
Principal Sum of Seventy pounds secured to Miss  
Hards of Bingham aforesaid and of the sum of One  
hundred and thirty pounds secured to Henry Workman  
of Bingham aforesaid Gentlemen by an Indenture dated  
the 11<sup>th</sup> day of July One thousand eight hundred and forty four  
and the Interest due in respect thereof respectively And  
whereas we the said Thomas Sharp and Harriet Sharp  
having occasion to borrow the sum of Twenty pounds  
have applied to the said Henry Workman to lend us the  
same at Interest after the rate of five pounds per centum  
per annum which he hath agreed to do or having the  
same secured by the title of Hard of the said Thomas  
Sharp bearing even date herewith and by these presents  
Now we do hereby acknowledge and Declare  
that in consideration of the said sum of Twenty  
pounds of good and lawful British Money to the  
said Thomas Sharp or lent advanced and paid by the  
said Henry Workman before the signing hereof the  
receipt whereof we do hereby acknowledge We the  
above named and undersigned Thomas Sharp and  
Harriet Sharp do hereby charge and make liable all  
and singular the said Eight Cottages and Gardens  
and other hereditaments comprised in the before  
mentioned Indenture with the payment of the said sum  
of Twenty pounds unto the said Henry Workman  
his heirs executors administrators or assigns with interest  
for the same after the rate of five pounds per centum  
per annum from the day of the date hereof without any  
deduction or abatement thereout in any respect whatsoever  
And we do hereby for ourselves and each of us for  
himself and herself and by and her and his executors  
administrators and assigns agree with the said Henry  
Workman his executors administrators and assigns that



The aforesaid Indenture of Mortgage shall remain in his  
or their Custody or power without the let or hindrance  
of us the said Thomas Sharp and Harriet Sharp or either  
of us our or either of our heirs executors administrators or  
assigns so long as the said sum of Twenty pounds  
principal and advanced and the Interest thereof or any  
part thereof respectively shall remain due and owing (and  
the same premises shall not be redeemed or redeemable  
until the said last mentioned sum and Interest shall  
be wholly paid off and discharged And also that in case  
we the undersigned Thomas Sharp and Harriet Sharp our  
heirs executors administrators or assigns shall not repay the said  
sum of Twenty pounds for Demand or within twenty  
one Days afterwards with Interest for the same in manner  
aforesaid then we do hereby agree that we will at any time  
hereafter upon the request of the said Henry Workman his  
executors administrators or assigns but at our own costs and  
Charges make and conde into the said Henry Workman  
his executors administrators and assigns any further security  
as he or they may deem necessary or advisable for better  
or more effectually charging the aforesaid premises with  
the repayment to him and them of the aforesaid sum  
of Twenty pounds and the Interest thereof.
