the Year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and thirteen

The Condition of this Obligation is such. That if the above-burden

Heirs, Executors, or Administrators, or any or either of them shall and do
well and truly pay or cause to be paid unto the above-named William Collett

his

Executors, Administrators, or Assigns, the full Sum of Two hundred and
Twenty Pounds

of good and lawful Money of Great Britain
together with Interest for the same of like lawful money after the
rate of Five Pounds per Centum per Annum upon the ninth Day
of July next ensuing the date hereof without fraud or further delay. Then this Obligation to be void and of none Effect or
else to remain in full Force and Virtue.
