#### WHERE THE MONEY IS SPENT

In the past few years the PTA has provided extra computers for the school so there is at least one machine in each class room. Each year they have also purchased extra books for the school library and paid for the drama entertainment for the Childrens Christmas Party.

This year's fund raising is going towards the provision of equipment to encourage the children to revive some of the traditional playground games. This is not a totally original idea; the benefits to the harmony of break times have been well publicised in newspapers and on the radio. Balls, skipping ropes and other items of traditional play equipment have been purchased already and placed in bins that can easily be tidied away. Each item of equipment only cost a small amount so the money has gone a long way. Next term, with Mr Hughes' full support, the PTA intend to raise funds to have the playground painted with games including hopscotch, snakes and ladders, roads and a compass. This will not only provide play opportunities but the designs that have been seen will also be useful as support to some classroom activities.
